Pastor Nominating Committee Report

The Pastor Nominating Committee, PNC, has been diligently reading the profiles submitted through PC(USA) Church Leadership Connection and sorted as possible candidates for Trinity. Using various criteria to choose possible candidates, calls were made to the persons listed as references by the potential candidates and background checks conducted. Sermons from their church websites or YouTube were also previewed.

From these initial calls, the committee then scheduled times to have a conference call with each candidate, asking the same questions and allowing them to answer or elaborate as they saw fit. This process was interesting as no party could see one another to determine body language or pick up on any visual clues as the questions were answered.

Following the conference call, those candidates selected for further interviews were scheduled for a "SKYPE call." SKYPE is a calling program using a computer/laptop/tablet/or smart-phone allowing individuals to actually speak and see one another in a live conference call. The PNC

developed questions they felt would allow the candidate an opportunity to express their views on various topics relating to the call of a pastor to Trinity Presbyterian. The questions were sent to each candidate ahead of time so that they would have time to reflect and prepare a response. Following the questioning section, the candidates were allowed the opportunity of asking questions of the PNC members.

The next step in the process is to schedule the potential candidates to speak locally so that the committee can see them in action in front of a live congregation. Three local Presbyterian churches are possible venues for this process. The PNC will have the opportunity to begin a relationship with the candidate and the candidate will be able to experience our community during this visit.
