## "Joel's Jottings"

The beginning of the year is a time for reporting! The annual congregational meeting will be held on Wednesday February 18. A pot luck supper starts at 5:30 and the meeting begins at 6. Following the meeting there will be an Ash Wednesday service as we begin the season of Lent.

An annual meeting is a time to review where we have come from as well as look ahead to where we are going. One fact was shared with me at a recent staff meeting that I found fascinating. In 2014 there were 416 prayer requests received and offered up through the Trinity Presbyterian Church. Many Sundays we share some or all of these in worship. In addition, part of the church staff meeting each week to hear these requests and offer our prayers for each person and situation. There we included birthdays and celebrations as well as other concerns. Then we send a note card to the individual for whom we prayed.

416 over the course of the year. (Actually we didn't start this until the end of January – still that is a lot of requests – about 10 per week). And this doesn't count the prayers shared

through the church prayer chain or other church groups and members!

We don't always know the results of our prayers. But we offer them in hope. Our hope is for a desired result, no doubt. But hope is also for a change in attitude or heart to prepare us for whatever happens. We pray to share our constancy and hope. God is at work in the world. Our prayers reveal that.

As Paul shared with the church at Philippi:

*Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

May we continue in our prayers in 2015.




## Sewing Hope
