Trinity Presbyterian Church, Clearwater practices a values-based faith for all people. We welcome and accept anyone who seeks spiritual, intellectual, and physical wholeness and well-being. We seek ways to serve God and love our neighbors in our time and place.

We follow a vision of ministry grounded in the teaching and life of Jesus where all people come to know God's loving Presence. Our mission within this vision is Jesus' concise summation of the gospel, to inspire lives by loving God with all our Soul, Mind, and Heart, and our neighbor as ourselves.

We understand our traditional Christian beliefs are mere thresholds into the multiplicity of God's presence in all creation. Open to the transforming power of God's Spirit, we seek to accept all people and allow room for diverse interpretations of faith. We welcome different approaches to serve God and respect one another's values and beliefs. We all seek common ground in the life and ministry of Jesus and trust that God's truth is always bigger than any one particular community of faith's interpretation of that truth.

We do our best to remain open to the transforming presence of God's love throughout creation, in our scriptures, and within our own lives. We live as best we can by values expressed in our scriptures and shared by humanity across divisions of national origin, color, gender, sexuality, age, physical ability, socio-economics, ideology, doctrine and belief.

#### What is the congregation's or organization's vision for ministry:

Vision for ministry: "ALL people know God's loving presence".

Trinity church practices values-based worship through acts of service. Matthew 25:31–46 calls all of us to actively engage in the world around us, so our faith comes alive. We learn the needs of our community first, then act boldly and compassionately to serve our community, feed the hungry, love the oppressed, and care for the poor. We use Zoom and Facebook to maintain congruency in all we did pre-pandemic. Our Sunday services, the Kids ministry, Adult Sunday School, Wednesday night study sessions, and much more continue, albeit virtually. For the community:Trinity Clearwater Preschool: We offer an affordable Bilingual Christian Preschool. Mission Trips: We provide camps and mission trips for our older youth. Fellowship Hall: A valued resource for many local events, including Tampa Bay Symphony Orchestra rehearsals, Clearwater High School activities, social events, and wedding receptions. Sunday Hot Lunch: Volunteers prepare an affordable meal for church members once a month that is free for first time guests. Holiday Meals: Dozens of seasonal meals are delivered to needy families in our area. Manna Box: Outside our church office is an active repository for non-perishable items to feed the less fortunate in our community.

We remain focused on the needs and care of our congregation by holding regular Deacon and Session meetings. Our outreach missions are discussed in Narrative Question #2

#### How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

Trinity has 5 active missions. We donate money, time and talents to each of these missions and are visibly making a difference in the lives of others in our community and in Tanzania, Africa.

Skycrest Elementary School. We service the Skycrest Elementary School by volunteering in the classrooms and during their lunch time. We also donate money for activities and donations of school supplies.

Clothes to Kids. We provide money, new socks, underwear and gently used clothing to the Clothes to Kids Foundation. This mission provides help to the children in the low-income families in Pinellas County.

Friends of Hope. We prepare and serve breakfast twice a month at Project Hope to as many as 100 homeless adults. At Christmas time we give packages of gifts with their necessary personal needs.

Shalom Orphanage. We support 98 orphans at the Shalom Orphanage in Tanzania, Africa by sending donations of money for food and supplies such as a well for clean water, bunkbeds, school uniforms etc. We also support 2 orphans so they can attend Tumaini Junior School.

Sewing Hope. The members of the Sewing Hope Ministry sew blankets for the Foster Children and sick besides teaching advanced sewing techniques.

Additionally, Trinity Clearwater founded "Sermons of Service". Each month having five Sundays we conduct a short worship service, then perform seasonal and helpful community service projects that illuminates Trinity's light in our area.

How will this position help you to reach your vision and mission goals:

The pastor will be the spiritual and administrative leader of our church family, and will initially be a co-pastor with our current pastor, as an equal. The pastor will ensure that our current outreach, educational, and servce programs are well supported while also expanding our thinking to new possibilities. We welcome change, as needed, for our spiritual growth.

The pastor will understand and support the needs of an aging congregation, who still serve our mission with vigor, while also making the church an open and welcoming environment for all newcomers. Trinity is focused on being inclusive, and the pastor will nurture this value. By being caring and understanding, the pastor will support our existing congregation, welcome new members, and reach out to the community around us.

We want to be pushed and challenged to a new and more positive course for our future. We are in need of a pastor who will guide us through changes necessary to improve our work and be a significant leader of spiritual growth.

Our pastor will continue with us on our journey of value-based faith, and grow with us on this path. Ideally our pastor will have a working knowledge of Spanish to help reach out to the changing multicultural community around us.

### Provide a description of the characteristics needed by the person who is open to being called to this congregation and or organization:

We need a co-pastor who will work with our current pastor to provide leadership together in all areas of the church, with an emphasis on worship, missional and strategic planning, discipleship and faith formation, and church administration and overall staff supervision. The co-pastors will work with the session to guide the ministry and mission of the congregation while serving as a pastoral presence in the community. We pray for a pastor who demonstrates energy and is keenly aware of the opportunities to advance the work of the church.

Our co-pastor should be energetic and enthusiastic, a great communicator, and an innovator. He/she should be able to work closely with an aging congregation and have experience with younger people to encourage and support our recent new members who are younger as well. We need someone who recognizes the need to keep old traditions alive while reinventing ourselves through connections with the community.

This person called to our congregation needs to be friendly and outgoing, have proven leadership qualities, and be willing to work as a team player.

The person called to this position will have knowledge in God's word and be a clear and concise teacher who creates scripturally sound and strong sermons that reach our diverse congregation. As a result, we desire to continue as a viable church/congregation as we are called to imitate Christ and serve the real needs of real people in our community.
